Nominations for the above positions shall open on 7 August at 9am and close on 25 August at 4:30pm. Nominations shall be submitted via the online voting system and students will be emailed a link this week which will give access to this system.

Students who do not receive the email link should first check that their email system has not blocked or filtered the email which is sent from “bigpulse.com”. If there is still a problem after this step, students can contact AuSM to find out how they can obtain a nomination link email.

Please note that only AuSM members are allowed to stand as a candidate and each nomination must be supported by two members of AuSM. **Hard copy or late nominations will not be accepted.**

All AUT students are entitled to vote in the election.
